Response to the Community Health Needs Assessment

This document outlines Hills and Dales Health Care response to the priority health needs identified in the hospital's 2022 Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA). The assessment process expanded on a regional assessment process led by the Thumb Community Health Partnership. Once priorities were selected, the CHNA Team discussed work already completed as part of the 2019 CHNA Implementation Plan and existing services and programs. Gaps in services were identified and strategies were developed. This plan will be used to guide activities over the next three years. An annual report will be prepared and provided to meet CHNA requirements. Existing strategies and programs will be maintained and strengthened as opportunities arise.
